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## 2022 Activities and Accomplishments

Since our last annual meeting, ASA has been working hard to support the industry. Among many accomplishments throughout the year, highlights include:

- Contracting for the 2021 IBC Engineering Standards with Reference Engineering. The standards should be available for use by members in communities that have adopted the 2021 IBC in early 2023.
- Maricopa County has adopted the 2018 IBC, and we are in the process of submitting our 2018 engineering to them for official approval. Members will know immediately once the approval has been provided.
- ASA has been working with the City of Phoenix to add the sign industry to their existing Self-Certification Program. The Self-Certification Program allows a registered professional (Arizona licensed contractor (C-38) to bypass the normal review process and get permits in one to five business days. Participating professionals must meet minimum qualifications and attend a Self-Certification training class. The city is currently developing the sign industry-specific training class. We will pilot the program with permits that the city has typically issued over-the-counter. This program has also been adopted by the cities of Surprise and Peoria. We hope that additional expansion will take place once more jurisdictions understand the benefit of the program.
- ASA hosted Signs 101 for the City of Phoenix staff at Smithcraft on July 26<sup>th</sup>, 2022
- ASA hosted its Annual Tabletop meeting at Topgolf on October 19<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Everyone
  who attended enjoyed a fun night of food, drinks, prizes for those who visited all
  Tabletop Vendors and of course Top Golf's driving range.
